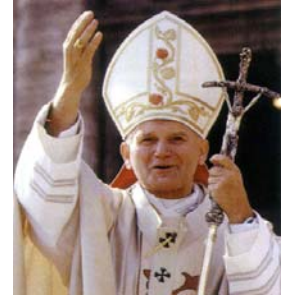

### **The Power of a Pure Heart**
